

Kent Street Gallery is an exhibition space at the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts, showcasing a diverse range of work with a focus on local and early career artists.



The works compare Perth, the capital city of Western Australia on the coast of Indian Ocean with the artist's home town of Bhaktapur, Nepal.




In this exhibition, Ailsa Waddell aims to investigate how the spaces around us are constructed.

Kickett explores the devastated state of the lakes and river systems that were once vital life sources for his people in the Ballardong region.


Rohin has endeavoured to preserve the image of these sights, before they are completely destroyed.

A selection of wearable silk and felted pieces accompany the exhibition, demonstrating recurring use of earthly colours and repeated lines.


