Art Materials and Aprons

Art materials are provided for all our classes. Art aprons are provided for Art Studio classes and art shirts are provided for Junior Artists 4 to 6yrs. Each class is taken by an experienced art teacher with a maximum of 12 Junior Artists or 14 Studio Artists. Parents are not required to stay with their child.

Age Range

Our art activities are planned by a professional artist and fully qualified and experienced primary school art teacher.

The age range for classes varies depending on the complexity of the subject matter and the degree of difficulty. Please only enrol your child if they are within the specified age range. Junior Artist classes are for children aged 4, 5 or 6yrs old. Creative Kids Workshops are for students 7 to 14yrs.

Fine motor skills, manual dexterity and concept development have all been considered when determining the age range for each workshop. We want your child to have fun and to succeed with their art endeavours!
