Application process

Applications are assessed on artistic merit, emergent strengths, community relevance or novelty. All applicants require membership with the centre and can apply for membership [online](#).

Selection Criteria

To be considered for an exhibition all relevant information and supporting documentation must be submitted with the application. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered. Applicants will be informed if they are not successful. Proposals will be assessed on criteria including:

- / The quality of the work and conceptual cohesiveness of the proposal.
- / Exhibition's intent, content and rationale.
- / Any proposed artist talks or workshops in support of the exhibition.
- / Adequate material to enable assessment of the proposal.
- / Gallery availability
- / Consideration of the physical requirements of the exhibition space and artwork proposed.
- / Ability to contribute to a balanced exhibition program (i.e. similar/complimentary media or themes also exhibiting within the year).
- / Community/cultural relevance and inclusivity.
